From the mixed embeddedness approach to what? Migrant entrepreneurship at a glance

Sociologica (Italian Journal of Sociology) organises a **special thematic section on migrant and minority entrepreneurship** (to be published in mid-2018), edited by Eduardo Barberis (University of Urbino) and Giacomo Solano (Eindhoven University of Technology). The provisional title of the special section is '*From the mixed embeddedness approach to what? Migrant entrepreneurship at a glance*'.

The special section focuses on the mixed embeddedness approach (Kloosterman, Rath and Van Der Leun, 1999; Kloosterman and Rath, 2001) as a lens to understand the development of the field of migrant and minority entrepreneurship. We are looking for articles that, starting from the mixed embeddedness approach, provide a contribution from either a theoretical/conceptual standpoint or an empirical one. We are particularly interested in conceptual contributions that integrate the approach (suggesting advancements, reinterpretation and redefinition of this seminal approach), and theoretically-grounded empirical studies that concretely apply it.

Scholars interested in submitting a research work to the Special Section should submit an abstract of approx. 250 words to giacomo.solano@gmail.com and eduardo.barberis@uniurb.it before 1 September 2017. Once feedback is received on the submitted abstract, full papers (6000-8000 words, abstract and references included) should be submitted by e-mail, using word attachments, to the special section editors before 11 December 2017. The first page of the paper must contain

the title, author(s), affiliation and contact information for the corresponding author. All the papers will be double-blind peer reviewed. Please feel free to contact the editors if you need further information.
