United Nations University objectives

The United Nations University (UNU) is an international community of scholars engaged in research, postgraduate teaching and capacity development, and dissemination of knowledge in furtherance of the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations. The United Nations University Institute on Globalization, Culture and Mobility (UNU-GCM) is one of several research and training institutes of the UNU. Based in Barcelona, it works to contribute to good governance, cultural diversity, democracy and human rights through a better understanding of cultural mobility and diversity in the context of globalization, focusing especially on the major cultural and social phenomena of migration and media. The institute fosters cutting-edge research in these areas at global and local levels.

Responsibilities

This Research Assistant will work closely with the Senior Research Officer of UNU-GCM on identifying new research niches as well as designing and implementing a resource mobilization strategy.

We seek expressions of interest from graduates with proven experience of in-depth research and writing proposals skills.

The Research Assistant should demonstrate:

- Capacity to identify fundraising opportunities for the Institute's current research agenda;
- Capacity to identify emerging research niches in the areas of globalization, culture and mobility;
- Skills to draft proposals for a variety of donors;
- Willingness to support day-to-day activities;
- Strong qualitative and/or quantitative social science research skills;
- Excellent English-language writing skills; knowledge of Spanish is highly desirable

Required qualifications and experience

Required qualifications and experience include:

- Minimum qualification: graduate degree in international development, political science, economics, public administration, or related field;
- Demonstrated application of social science research skills to policy problems;
- Excellent communication and drafting skills, with proficiency in both oral and written English;
- Good team player with strong interpersonal skills demonstrated by the ability to work in a multicultural, multi-ethnic and multi-gender environment with sensitivity and respect for diversity.

Remuneration

Remuneration will be commensurate with qualifications and experience of the successful candidate. The successful candidate will be responsible for paying all taxes and any other fiscal obligations.

The individual contractor is expected to be based in Barcelona.

Duration of contract

This is full-time employment on a Contract for Individual Contractor (CIC) with UNU-GCM. The appointment will be for three (3) consecutive months. No individual contractor shall provide services for more than nine (9) calendar months within a twelve (12) consecutive month period. UNU does not sponsor a working visa for this position.

This is a locally recruited post; no relocation expenses or allowances apply. The successful candidate will be employed under a local contract and will not hold international civil servant status nor be a "staff member" as defined in the United Nations Staff Rules and Regulations.
