

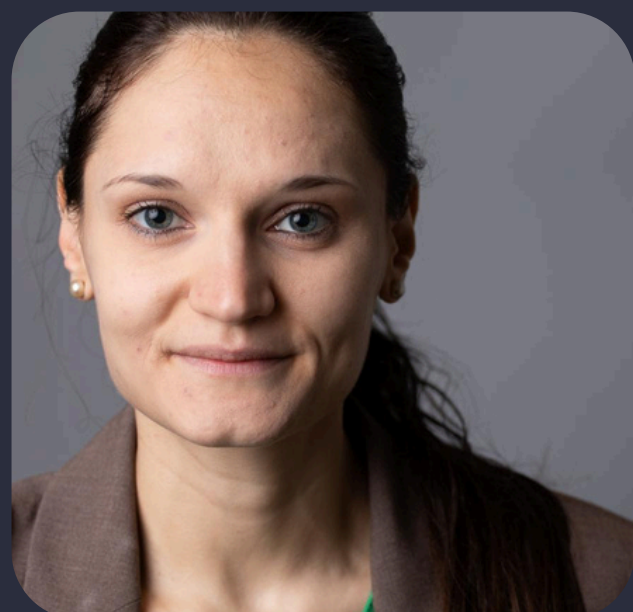

Dr Romina Istratii is UKRI Future Leaders Fellow at the School of History, Religions and Philosophies at SOAS University of London. Dr. Istratii will be presenting her transboundary work on domestic violence in the context of project dldl/ጉልጅል, a research and innovation project that emerged from long-term, participatory and ethnographic engagement with faith communities in East Africa and migrant communities in the UK. The project promotes locally-grounded, religio-culturally sensitive and integrated responses to domestic violence and abuse (DVA) internationally.
